



VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

To: The Stakeholders of Ziff Davis

APEX Companies LLC (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and total energy consumption reported by Ziff Davis, Inc. (Ziff Davis) for the period stated below. This Verification Opinion Declaration applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions and total energy consumption is the sole responsibility of Ziff Davis. Ziff Davis is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions statement and total energy consumption in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions and total energy consumption reported, and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze, and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG emissions statement and total energy consumption based on the verification. Verification activities applied in a limited level of assurance verification are less extensive in nature, timing, and extent than in a reasonable level of assurance verification.

Boundaries of the reporting company GHG emissions covered by the verification:

- Operational Control
- Worldwide

Types of GHGs: CO₂, CH₄, N₂O, HFCs

Total Energy Consumption: 7,937 megawatt hours

GHG Emissions Statement:

- Scope 1: 125 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- Scope 2 (Location-Based): 1,624 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent^{1,2}
- Scope 2 (Market-Based): 1,183 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent^{1,3}
- Scope 3 Category 1 – Purchased Goods and Services: 32,277 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent

Data and information supporting Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 GHG emissions were in most cases estimated rather than historical in nature.

Period covered by GHG emissions and energy verification:

- January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025

Criteria against which verification was conducted:

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2)

¹ Scope 2 Location- and Market-based emissions from colocation data centers were nearly all estimated. Due to the varying degree of electricity consumed by these sources, the material difference to actual emissions generated is uncertain. Based on the information available, the estimation methodology was deemed appropriate.

² Scope 2 Location-based emissions applied IEA Emission Factors Package 2025 Edition, using provisional 2024 CO₂ emissions factors.

³ Scope 2 Market-based U.S. Green-e residual mix emission factors applied CO₂ only; the impact on emissions is less than 1%.

Reference Standard:

- ISO 14064-3 (2019-04) Second Edition: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements

Level of Assurance:

- Limited
- This verification used a materiality threshold of 5% for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.

GHG and Energy Verification Methodology:

Evidence gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Ziff Davis and their consultant;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by Ziff Davis and their consultant;
- Review of Ziff Davis's data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis, and review of information used to determine energy consumption and GHG emissions; and
- Audit sample of data used by Ziff Davis to determine energy consumption and GHG emissions.

Verification Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions statement shown above:

- is not materially correct and is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2), and WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3).

It is our opinion that Ziff Davis has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation, and analysis of quantitative data for determination of GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.



Statement of independence, impartiality, and competence
